

Passeio recife de fora porto seguro

O Parque Natural Municipal Marinho Recife de Fora (PNMM Recife de Fora) é composto por ecossistema recifal formado por um mosaico de ambientes, situado no litoral do município de Porto Seguro no estado da Bahia a uma distância de 1,34 km da costa e abrange uma área de 19,68 km². O PNMM Recife de Fora foi criado pela Lei Nº 260/97, de 16 de dezembro de 1997, visando "resguardar os atributos excepcionais da natureza da região", bem como "a proteção integral da flora, da fauna e demais recursos naturais, com utilização para objetivos educacionais, científicos e recreativos". Conhecido por sua alta biodiversidade e endemismo, o PNMM Recife de Fora está inserido em uma área prioritária para a conservação da biodiversidade e serve de habitat e abrigo para vários grupos marinhos como algas, gramas marinhas e uma diversidade de fauna (invertebrados). Além de abrigar espécies ameaçadas de extinção, como por exemplo, o coral-cérebro-da-bahia (Mussismilia braziliensis), o mero (Epinephelus itajara), a tartaruga-verde (Chelonia mydas), o boto-cinza (Sotalia guianensis) e muitas outras espécies. Além disso, a manutenção da conservação do platô recifal é de extrema importância para proteger a zona costeira das ações da maré.
